- Allows restaurants, private clubs, Class A retailers (taverns and private wine restaurants) and wineries physically located within the above cities or counties to sell alcoholic liquors, wine and non-intoxicating beer as their licenses allow beginning at 10:00 a.m. on Sundays for on-premises consumption only.
- Allows distilleries, mini-distilleries, wineries and farm wineries physically located within the above cities or counties to offer complimentary samples of alcohol beginning at 10:00 a.m. on Sunday for on-premises consumption only. No retail bottle sales are permitted for distilleries and mini-distilleries on Sunday. Wineries and farm wineries with the proper licensure may sell bottles after 1:00 p.m. on Sunday for off-premises consumption.
- Any questions concerning eligibility for Sunday 10:00 a.m. alcohol sales should be directed to the appropriate municipality or county.
