## WEST VIRGINIA APPROVED WINE BAGS

The bags from the following companies have been approved and accepted by the West Virginia Alcohol Beverage Control Commission for use by West Virginia licensees that are permitted to serve wine with meals for on-premise consumption. Only a private club or private wine restaurant licensee may use the approved wine bag. Such licensees are permitted to re-cork and re-seal up to two bottles of unconsumed wine that was served in conjunction with a meal or food purchase excluding beverages, tax, gratuity, or other fees exceeding \$15.00. Additionally, the licensees that have purchased the additional \$100.00 license may sell at retail one bottle of sealed wine for consumption off premised. All wine re-corked and re-sealed or sold from a licensed premise must be placed in an approved tamper resistant bug thus allowing their customers to remove the wine from the licensed premise for consumption off of the licensed premise.

All bags sold for use in West Virginia must have affixed or embossed to each wine bag the following in a 12 pitch font, Times New Roman, Bold: **"WVABCA APPROVED BAG"**
